GPG is delighted to inform that we have two new members of the Ryan Corner wind farm's team on board:

- Tom Doake has commenced work as a civil works supervisor and will work closely with the Balance of Plant contractors (Decmil Group Australia and RJE Global) to ensure the access tracks, foundations and electrical works are completed and ready to commence wind turbine installation later this year.
- Garry Rister has commenced work as a work health and safety and environment supervisor and will work closely with the Balance of Plant and installation contractors (Decmil Group Australia, RJE Global and Vestas) to ensure the works are carried out in a safe and environmentally sound manner.

Project Status

- Wind farm planning permit and associated plans:
 - ✓ The amendment to the permit and its accompanying development plans has been granted. A copy is available on the Ryan Corner wind farm web site.
 - ✓ Commencement of the construction foreseen in May 2022.
 - ✓ Preparatory works have commenced on Youls Road. There will be a road closure on Youls Road from Fingerboard Road to Davidsons Road from March 28 to May 4.
- Connection application & agreements:
 - ✓ A fresh partial application was submitted to AEMO at the end of 2021 and to be completed by May.
 - ✓ Agreements on-going.

Activities On Site

- Under progress:
 - ✓ Finalising project scheduling and access with associated landowners.
 - ✓ The first components (blades, nacelles, hubs and rotors) have been unloaded and stored at Portland.
 - ✓ Cultural Heritage inductions have been completed for Youls Road upgrade and the wind farm site.

Project Status

- Wind farm planning permit:
 - ✓ The assessment of the planning permit amendment application is progressing within the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning. Development and management plans required to be endorsed prior to the commencement of development have been submitted to the Minister for Planning for approval.
- Connection application & agreements:
 - ✓ Due Diligence Review of the connection application by AEMO in progress
 - ✓ Agreements on-going.

Activities On Site

- Under progress:
 - ✓ Finalising project scheduling and access with associated landowners.
 - ✓ Geotechnical investigations on the Tarrone Lane Moyne River bridge completed.

Transmission Line and Tarrone Terminal Station

Construction works for the transmission line and collector substation and at the terminal station are due to commence in 2022.

The Cultural Heritage Management Plan will be submitted to Eastern Maar Aboriginal Corporation shortly for assessment and endorsement.

Community Engagement and Benefit Sharing Plan

The Community Engagement and Benefit Sharing Plan (CEBSP) implemented in each project includes a neighbour benefit sharing program. This program provides a voluntary neighbour benefit deed to neighbours within 2km of the wind farm. The purpose of the deed is to recognise that those living closest to the wind farm may be impacted by the activities at the site during the construction and operation periods and to offer a benefit that can be used to offset these impacts. Similar neighbour benefit sharing programs are commonly provided to residents that live in the vicinity of wind farms in Australia.

Voluntary Neighbour Program

The voluntary neighbour deed is negotiated individually with each neighbour and is available at any time during the construction and operational period. In the event that the neighbour sells the property, a new voluntary deed will be offered and negotiated with the new owner if they wish to join the neighbour benefit program. The voluntary deed will provide benefits until the wind farm has been decommissioned.

Entering into the voluntary deed does not restrict the owner of the residence in any activities on their own property. Instead, it enables neighbours to share in the benefits generated by the wind farm. The voluntary deed has no effect on their rights to take action through the endorsed complaints process if the wind farm operates outside its obligations under the planning permit.

Berrybank Wind Farm

Australia's first renewable energy training tower has been officially opened at Federation University Australia in Ballarat.

The 23-metre-high tower is Stage 1 of the Asia Pacific Renewable Energy Training Centre (APRETC).

GPG was among companies who collectively provided \$1.8 million for APRETC with the initial business case funded with \$50,000 from the Victorian Government, contributing with \$200,000.

With the opening of the wind turbine training tower, Federation TAFE is on track to start delivering Global Wind Organisation (GWO) Standard Basic Safety Training and Basic Refresher Training in the middle of the year.

Federation University expects to eventually train over 600 people a year, providing a pipeline of skilled workers for the fast-growing wind energy sector.

Planning for Stage 2 of APRETC is underway and will include a classroom, workshop, and training equipment to deliver specialised training courses, including training for blade repair technicians.

APRETC is part of Federation's goal to be the leading industry and government partner for skills, training and research in new energy technologies.
