

Ryan Corner Wind Farm

Project Status

- Wind farm planning permit and associated plans:
 - ✓ The amendment to the permit and its accompanying development plans has been granted. A copy is available on the Ryan Corner wind farm web site.
 - ✓ Mobilisation and site compound establishment (East site entrance Hamilton Port Fairy Road) commenced in July.
- Connection application & agreements:
 - ✓ Connection application submitted to AEMO is in progress.
 - ✓ Agreements on-going, the Connection Services Agreement is executed

Activities On Site

- Under progress:
 - ✓ All of the components (blades, nacelles, hubs and rotors) have arrived and are being stored at Portland.
 - ✓ Cultural Heritage Inductions are continuing as contractors come on site.
 - ✓ 62 people have been fully inducted to work on the site.
 - ✓ Native vegetation and culturally sensitive sites are fenced and protected. An education session was held to ensure the protection of native vegetation.
 - ✓ Fencing contractor is continuing with internal fencing.
 - ✓ The site compound and amenities buildings are delivered. Final fitting out is underway and will be ready by mid-October.
 - ✓ Building of access tracks continues, mobile crusher units are working alongside plant as they work their way from both the east and west entrances.

Construction Work Hours

Civil construction earthworks have now commenced on Ryan Corner wind farm to construct the access tracks and hardstands. Generally, the civil contractor will be working:

- ✓ Monday to Friday:.....7am to 6pm
- ✓ Saturday:......7am to 4pm (regular)
- ✓ Sunday/Public Holiday: 7am to 1pm (occasional as required)

Saturday afternoon (1pm to 4pm) and Sunday/Public Holiday, works will be restricted to "managed impact" and "low impact" works as defined by the EPA guidelines.

Transmission Line and Tarrone Terminal Station

- ✓ Works on the 132kV switchyard at the Tarrone Terminal Station started on Thursday 1 September. The laydown area for material storage is in progress.
- ✓ Project site office facilities have been installed.
- ✓ Construction works for the transmission line are due to commence in October 2022.
- ✓ A Native Vegetation Removal Permit for the transmission line is progressing.

GPG Australia – Other News

Spanish Minister for Industry, Trade and Tourism officially opens Naturgy's first battery storage centre worldwide in Australia



The Spanish Minister for Industry, Trade and Tourism travelled to Australia to officially open the Queanbeyan Battery Centre. The minister was joined by the Spanish Ambassador, the Managing Director of GPG, the Director-General for International Trade and Investments, the Head of the Economic and Trade Office, the Director of the Spanish Chamber of Commerce and Trade, GPG Head of Development in Australia and other members of the GPG Australia team.

The Queanbeyan Battery Centre is the first storage facility that Naturgy will put into operation anywhere in the world. It is located in the Australian Capital Territory, close to the city of Canberra, and will perform a strategic role in support of the local distribution network.

Based on a 10 MW system of Lithium-Ion batteries and a storage capacity of 20 MWh, the Queanbeyan centre will be able to accumulate electricity from renewable sources and output it to the grid whenever it is needed at times when less electricity is being generated.

In this way, the facility will not only strengthen supply but will also contribute to promoting the energy transition in Australia, guaranteeing the presence of clean energy in the network in a continuous and stable manner. The project is tied to the construction of the Berrybank 2 wind farm, which the group will begin to operate in the coming months.
